Bridgetown Netball Association reserves the right to remove anyone from the Bridgetown Greenbushes Leisure Centre or (or related venues) who does not abide by the following code.

Remember children participate in sport for various reasons and for their enjoyment.

1. Play by the rules and encourage children to play by the rules.
2. Cooperate with Coaches, Team Members, Opponents and Officials.
3. Respect the decision of the officials and teach young people to do the same.
4. Respect the rights of all players regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
5. Encourage children to participate – do not force them.
6. Never ridicule or yell at a player.
7. Focus on the child's efforts and encourage fair play rather than if they win or lose.
8. Appreciate and encourage good performance/sportsmanship by all participants by applauding good play.
9. Give all Players fair and reasonable court time – team effort achieves more.
10. Show concern and caution towards sick and injured players.
11. Show all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the game.
12. Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
13. Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved in the association.
14. Respect equipment provided.
15. Act in accordance with the law, show courtesy & respect for other people & property within the Netball Association, Social Media and within our local community.
